






Game Lofters unfazed by impending zombie apocalypse




"For SIGN ME UP community is about supporting one another, being there for each other, being unified to fight against systemic injustice, being each other's keeper," said Emily Mancini-Fitch, with the Portland Housing Authority.

In Saco, members of the First Parish Church offered free meals, haircuts, groceries and clothing to about 100 people in need. Organizers said it was part of an annual effort to answer King's question: "What are you doing for others?"

"We open our doors every year at this time -- this is our 12th year -- and we just have free services -- whatever we have service providers for, whatever we can give that's donated, to hand out," said Christine Galasyn of the First Parish Church.

Best event was the Maine's NAACP 39th annual MLK dinner held at the Holiday Inn by the Bay. About 300 guests showed up to hear speakers deliver remarks about race relations, justice

Maine Turnpike Authority includes Saco improvements in 4-year capital plan

Work, scheduled to commence in 2022, is estimated at \$40 million.

SACO — A project designed to improve safety for motorists around the Saco interchange on the Maine Turnpike has been included in the Maine Turnpike Authority's 4-year capital investment plan. The MTA board approved the capital plan in mid-December. Included as part of it is \$40 million for improvements to the Saco interchange, with

the exact nature and full scope of the work to be determined, according to the plan document. MTA spokeswoman Erin Courtney on Thursday said the work is scheduled to begin in 2022, though the design of the project is expected to begin later this year, as is the permitting process. The project comes following a joint study between the MTA, the City of Saco and the Maine Department of

Transportation, released in July 2019. The study looked at several areas including Route 112 as well as the turnpike interchange and made a number of recommendations. Sen. Justin Chenette, D-Saco, on social media Thursday morning said he had introduced L.D. 1390, in the last legislative session on behalf of the Saco delegation to address traffic issues associated with the turnpike and Route 112. The bill would have provided

\$24 million in DOT funding for the project. The bill summary noted that the joint study had recommended the MTA invest 40 percent, the Maine Department of Transportation 40 percent, and the city of Saco 20 percent. In his April 18, 2019, testimony on the bill, Chenette said his goal was to get the MTA to put the project in their 4-year capital plan. He requested the

Biddeford issues permits for 2 mill projects

BIDDEFORD — Two major mill redevelopment projects now have municipal permits, Biddeford city officials said in a news release issued last week. The City of Biddeford's Code Enforcement Department has issued building permits for the first phase of construction at the Lincoln Mill and for the first phase of a separate project at the Riverdam Mill.

On Jan. 13, building permits for the Lincoln Mill were issued to LHL Holdings, LLC for 148 new residential units; the city received \$244,010 in permit fees for the project said the city's Communications Coordinator Danica Lamontagne.

Earlier this month, Biddeford Code Enforcement officials also issued a building permit to Draft Room, LLC for the first phase of renovations to the Riverdam Mill, which includes 25 residential units and two commercial units in Building 4, at 24 Pearl St. In total, \$3.1 million is to be invested in Riverdam Building 4. Permit fees totaled \$44,485, Lamontagne said.

"I am pleased to see both of these major projects moving forward," said Mayor Alan Casavant. "The renovations of these historically significant buildings are an important milestone in the revitalization of Biddeford's downtown."

City officials say these projects along with others, like a 250-unit apartment complex planned for a site off Barra Road, shows Biddeford's residential growth is continuing.

"Just two weeks into 2020, we've


